

The 2nd Northern Flight and Clout Championships.

19th August 1956

The 2nd annual Northern Flight championship, held at Grange Park, Ribbleton, Preston, on Sunday 19th August attracted 47 entries. The open flight was won by R. Bamber, Preston Archers with a distance of 389yds. The target bow class was divided this year into two sections, viz up to and including 35lbs and up to and including 45lbs draw weight. This proved quite popular and saved quite a lot of argument as each bow was examined and entered into the class according to the makers branding. This brought out one interesting fact. In B.A., April/May issue, W. Davie commented that it was only brute force and a heavy bow that won in a flight shoot. Well, in the heavy bow class three competitors, all using the same weight of bow and only half an inch different in arrow length varied in distance by 90yds.; also the winner in this class using a 43lb bow was only 22yds in front of another competitor who was using a 36lb bow. A junior boy, 9years of age, using a 24lb steel bow and 24in arrows, shot a distance of 145yds. 2ft. and in trials after the shoot an alloy bow of 38lbs. beat all the distances shot that day. So I think that answers the question "does brute strength win?"
