



The 1974 Northern Counties and
Yorkshire Flight and Clout
Championships.

April 21st 1974

The Northern Counties and Yorkshire Flight and Clout Championships were held at Knavesmire, York on 21st April. There was a light wind from left to right from the rear. For the flight, four ends of three arrows were shot, and the best results appeared at the last end, although the 500 yards mark was beaten right from the start, by at least two competitors.

For the ladies, in the unlimited class, Jo Rodmell was first beating her own record with 408 yards 2 feet 9½ ins. 2nd and 3rd were Mrs. M. Thorley and Miss. A. Thorley with 376/1/5 and 357/0/4 respectively (all three ladies from Burton Constable Bowmen). 4th was Miss. M. Smith of Dearne Valley A.C. with a new first class flight of 319/0/6. 5th was Mrs. Wendy Hodgkinson (Eccles AC) with 304/1/3.

For the men, Alan Webster (Shardlow Archers) beat his own record to win with 695/0/2½. 2nd and 3rd were two new grand master flight shots, M. Walker 560/1/3 and G. Trotter, 556/2/3 (both of Burton Constable).
