New Judges

This month we have had one new candidate join us, Jason Lynch of Cheshire. Welcome to the team Jason.

Candidate Judges

Just a reminder that the next Candidate Seminar takes place on the 21st and 22nd of January. If you think that you would like to attend this, then the application is through the Sport80 website <https://agb.sport80.com>. All candidates must attend one of these seminars although they do take place twice a year so there is no rush for you to do so if you do not feel ready.

County Judges

It has come to my attention that you have not received your feedback on the County reaccreditation exam. I am told by the marking team that the feedback was sent from the email address judge.reaccreditation@archeryb.org can you check your spam/junk inboxes to make sure that it has not landed there. I will be asking the marking team to resend the feedback just to be sure.

Also for any County judges wishing to progress to Regional judges there is now a requirement for attendance at a 1 day workshop to be held at Lilleshall. This year the workshop will take place on the 4th of March and starts at 9.15. Applications for attendance are via the Sport80 platform. Instructions are attached. The event is a closed event so will only be visible in the platform to current county judges. If you are wishing to attend and cannot see the event, then please let me know.

National Tournaments

The National Tournament list for 2017 has been issued and should be on the AGB website. It has been sent out previously however it is attached here for those that have not yet seen it.

Uniform grant

The uniform grant has been extended for another 12 months. It applies to all current NCAS judges and all NCAS candidates who are successfully upgraded to County status. The grant can only be claimed once. The claim form is attached with this update.

National Conference

The 2017 National Conference will take place on the 5th of March at Lilleshall. This will only be one day event that will start at 9am and finish approximately 4pm. The event is open to all grades of judges. Regional and National Judges are reminded that attendance to 1 National Conference is a requirement in each 4-year reaccreditation cycle.
