### Quick Reference Cards

John Cunningham a Regional judge from Cheshire has kindly given me permission to publish a series of quick reference cards he has written. The information contained on the cards relates primarily to target and clout ranges and the items that you should be checking during your inspection prior to the tournament starting.

If you are going to print off the information it may be worthwhile laminating the paper, if you have access to a laminator, so as to prevent them getting damp and the ink running.
